



STATUS: SEASONAL (3 MONTHS)

TITLE: Life Guard

JOB DESCRIPTION: Under the supervision of the supervisor/manager, this position involves responsibility for maintaining orderly behaviour on the part of swimmers at X2O Adventures water Park protecting swimmers from injury or loss of life by drowning, and for rescuing those who might be in distress.

EDUCATION: High school diploma and higher is preferred; experience as a life guard but not required

EXPERIENCE: Specialized work in the enforcement and regulations and the protection of life at a beach.

CERTIFICATIONS: Life Guard training, First Aid, CPR.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Patrolling and observing the park and beach to ensure appropriate use by patrons, enforcing beach/park regulations, and responding to emergency situations.
- Work is performed independently in accordance with the established procedures, and is subject to review through visual observation and inspection by supervisor/manager.
- Be alert or prevent accidents (risk management).
- Respond quickly, intelligently, decisively and in accordance with established emergency and management procedures.
- Maintain a responsible, cordial and friendly attitude at all times.
- Assist with monitoring the facility and the conduct of patrons.
- Administer first aid and CPR as required.
- Perform general cleaning/maintenance within the park as assigned by the supervisor/manager.

- Inform the supervisor/manager of any damages to facility or equipment.
- Interact with guests and patrons in a positive customer service manner.
- Answer guest questions about the facility, property and surrounding area.
- Perform all other duties assigned by the supervisor/manager or his/her designee.

Position Requirements:

- Ability to react efficiently and effectively in emergency rescue situations.
- Ability to perform assigned tasks requiring physical strength and agility.
- Ability to react efficiently and tactfully with the public and to be capable of enforcing regulations firmly and impartially.
- Skills in open-water swimming, water rescue, accident prevention techniques, and water safety procedures.
- Must be physically fit and able to work out of doors for extended periods of time under adverse weather conditions.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Ability to understand and follow directions, and perform job functions under limited supervision.
- Excellent interpersonal communication and organizational skills.
- Ability to supervise activities of patrons, give directions, and enforce rules and regulations.
- Must possess critical thinking skills and be able to make sound decisions independently.
- Self-motivated with the ability to work without supervision.
- Must have the ability to work alone or in coordination with other team members to supervise activity on the park.
- Available to work weekends and holidays.
